Are you coming to the Installation on September 23rd?

Here's directions to St. James Church:

** (If you're coming from Northern State, go south on the Seaford Oyster Bay Expressway until you get to Southern State)

Take Southern State to Exit 29. That's Hicksville Road. Take it North about 1 1/2 miles (when you see Chapey Funeral Home, stay to your left!) until you see the Church on your left. It's at the last light before Hempstead Turnpike.

And from St. James to Delaney council.

After Mass, go one block North to Hempstead Turnpike. Go East about a mile on Hempstead Turnpike until you see a train trestle. That's Merritts Road. Go right on it and the council comes up quickly on the right hand side. Their phone's 752-5983.

And don't forget the September Assembly meeting at Floral Park Council

Wednesday, September 26th at 8:00 pm. At that meeting we're voting on the Assembly Budget you see on Page three.

Here's how to get to Floral Park Council

From the South, take Southern State Parkway to exit 13 (Linden Blvd.), go straight for two lights to Elmont Road. Make a right onto Elmont Road and take it about two miles. At the fork in the road, go left, crossing Hempstead Turnpike. Elmont Road becomes Plainfield Avenue. Cross Tulip Avenue in Floral Park, and keep going until you reach Woodbine. Go left on Woodbine to Tyson Avenue. Make a right on Tyson Avenue, and the council is two blocks up on your right. Park on the street.

From the East, take Jericho Turnpike West to Floral Park Look for Citibank on your right; Tyson Avenue is directly across from it. Make a left onto Tyson, and go two blocks, and the council is on the left. Park on the street.
