JUDGING

A **100-point scoring system** will be used to determine the winner.

40 Points: Content — How thoroughly is the topic examined?

25 Points: Grammar — How well is the essay written with respect to sentence and paragraph construction?

35 Points: Style — Does the essay show creativity, imagination and development of the topic in a logical and compelling style?
