RULES

- An entrant must be a child or grandchild of a Sir Knight in good standing with St John XXIII Assembly. (this includes children and grandchildren of the widow of a deceased SK that was in good standing)
- Essays must reflect the assigned theme and be the student's original work.
- Essays must be submitted to the Assembly by **April 3, 2023**.
- Essays must be typed and be between 500 and 750 words in length.
- The student's name should appear **only** on the official the **ST. JOHN XXIII ASSEMBLY CATHOLIC PATRIOTISM SCHOLARSHIP Essay Contest entry form**, which must be **stapled to the essay**.
- All entries become the property of the St. John XXIII Assembly No. 730 and may not be returned.

JUDGING

Judges (three or more) will be selected by the sponsoring Knights of Columbus assembly. Assembly members, teachers, clergy, civil officials and/or members of the community may serve as judges.

A **100-point scoring system** will be used to determine the winner.

40 Points: Content — How thoroughly is the topic examined?

25 Points: Grammar — How well is the essay written with respect to sentence and paragraph construction?

35 Points: Style — Does the essay show creativity, imagination and development of the topic in a logical and compelling style?
